Who is Equity Life Style (ELS)?

- Provides homeowners entry into Heron Cay Community via remote gate clickers and gate entry code

What is the Heron Cay Homeowners' Association (HOA)?

The Heron Cay HOA is the legal representative of all Heron Cay homeowners in keeping with Florida Statute chapter 723. The HOA is represented by a board of 5 to 7 Members that are elected by the Heron Cay HOA Members.

The HOA Acts as a Voice for all Community Members

Heron Cay Community is owned by Equity Life Style Corporation (ELS). The HOA is a strong and important voice of the community to maintain the health and attractiveness of living in the Heron Cay Community by protecting our rights and maintaining our lifestyle. Some of the HOA's activities include:

- Holding monthly meetings with the ELS Heron Cay Management Team and quarterly meetings with ELS Regional Management to present resident concerns and wishes and to monitor progress.
- Providing input for the annual ELS Capital Budget process for Heron Cay by providing a Wish List.
- Lobbying the government to ensure our collective voice is heard and taken seriously.
- Filing complaints with Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) on issues where there are specific concerns that ELS is not adequately addressing.
- Keeping community residents informed of changes in legislation that affect communities like Heron Cay and its homeowners.
- Monitoring monthly CPI (Consumer Price Index) and monthly market rate increases, and requiring corrections from ELS Management if warranted.
- Purchasing and providing liability insurance for all sponsored HOA events and activities.

Other Benefits the Heron Cay HOA Provides to the Our Community

- Maintaining the Heron Cay HOA Website (heroncayhoa.org) to keep residents informed of meeting
 minutes, upcoming events & activities, as well as pictures of those events and activities, and general
 information.
- Publishing a monthly newsletter updating community residents on issues, and activities & events, and general information.
- Hosting social events such as dances, BBQs, shows, BINGO, etc.
- Sponsoring and providing liability insurance for sanctioned sports, health, and other events.
- Offering opportunities for homeowners to connect and meet their neighbors.
- Maintaining a password-protected online resident directory (email, address, and phone #s) that is accessible to HOA members.

How Can a Homeowner Contribute to the Community?

Homeowners in Heron Cay can contribute by joining the HOA. After becoming a member, you might also consider running for election to the Heron Cay HOA Board.
