FROM THE HOA BOARD: Welcome to the month of November. We can't believe the year has gone by so fast! Most of our snowbirds have come back to the beautiful weather here in

Heron Cay – Welcome Home!!

Hurricane Milton was a terrible and destructive storm, spawning deadly tornadoes all over Florida. As we now know, at least 6 people in Spanish Lakes Country Club were killed and our hearts and prayers go out for everyone affected by this disaster. We here at Heron Cay, thankfully, were spared the worst of it.

Designs and proposals for a new Heron Cay entrance sign were submitted to corporate for approval and we hope to have a new sign before the end of the year.

Work is continuing with the painting and, in general, sprucing up of the street signs throughout the community.

ELS has purchased a new defibrillator, which is replacing the one that the HOA has had by the clubhouse backdoor near the bocce courts. Please take a moment to learn where it is in case of an emergency. The HOA's defibrillator was returned to us and is currently located in the HOA office, for the time being, until it is decided where we should best place it so it is accessible to all.

We had a 9-1-1 emergency phone in the pool area but it was removed some time ago because people were using it to make personal calls. Management is working with the phone company to determine if the line can be reactivated so that a phone can be installed. Once that does happen, it will only be able to be used to call 9-1-1.

Management is working with a vendor to install a projector in the auditorium so that Fun 'n' Games can begin to show movies.

As you know, there are no street lights along 90<sup>th</sup> Avenue on Heron Cay's side of the street. There is only one streetlight which is located directly across from our entrance. Management will be installing solar lights on both the entrance and exit sides of our community.

We were scheduled to host a 90-minute seminar from Florida Heart on CPR/AED but it was canceled due to lack of interest.

Management is looking into the feasibility of moving the fire pit from its current location, possibly to the area closer to either the bocce court or the tiki hut.

The bats need to be removed from the gazebo and the gazebo needs to be cleaned. Management will be getting estimates from vendors who specialize in bat removal. Once the bats are removed, there is a mesh that can be hung to deter the bats from nesting in the gazebo. Since bats are creatures of habit, this may take some time before they all leave for good.

Our landscaping company, Top Notch, has hired a new supervisor and he has replaced all the workers with a new crew. After almost a month of no lawn care, work finally started on October 15<sup>th</sup> and our community is looking much better. We hope this continues to be the case.

We know everyone's been very frustrated regarding the lawn care, or the lack thereof. This is totally understandable, however, taking anger out on Denise and Michele in the office is not necessary. We ask that our residents please take a deep breath before threatening staff members. There are some things that are "above their pay grades" and they have no control over.

The HOA 2025 membership drive kickoff was held all day on Saturday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, and we had a record 80 residents sign up for next year on the first day! Thank you!!! For our new residents, your 2025 membership will also be good for the remainder of 2024 so you can take advantage of any discounts members get for events this year as well as next year. Congratulations to Pauline Moldenhauer, the winner of the \$50 raffle drawing of all who signed up early for 2025.

Vivian Manno was at the membership drive kickoff selling tickets for the two upcoming "That's Entertainment" events scheduled for January and February. 





Lot Rent 90-day Notices issued to homeowners whose lease agreements are renewable February 2025 reflect September Consumer Price Index (CPI) figures as determined by the US Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics.

The September 2024 figure is **406.502**up from **486.086** for September 2023, an increase of **2.14** %.

Please note that the amount of increase may not result in a new lot rent in excess of market rent.




#### Instructions for using the Entry Gate

Our Gate Entry system is called a LiftMaster. It has many features to help make our community more secure. The gate entry codes were updated from 4 to 5 digits back in the early Summer of 2022. If you have not yet changed your code with the office, please do so. You may want to check the gate entry system box to determine if your name is in the community list. You can do that by visiting the box and using the arrows to scroll up and down to find your name.

A person can gain entry by a couple of ways

- 1. Residents may gain entry by using:
  - a. their 5 digit gate entry code, simply follow prompts on the gate entry system box.
  - b. AND, of course the resident may gain entry by using their remotes or their fobs.
- 2. Guests may gain entry by using:
  - a. a resident's 5 digit gate access (entry) code, simply follow prompts on the gate entry system box. Although residents are encouraged to NOT share your entry access entry code with others. Instead, have them utilize the calling feature.
- 3. Calling feature:
  - a. Guests may gain entry by using the LiftMaster touch screen. Instructional prompts are on the screen.
  - b. If the guest uses the calling method, you will receive a phone call from the gate or from the phone number of **772-999-6854**.
  - c. After speaking with the guest and deciding to allow the guest entry, the resident may open the gates by pressing **9** on their phone keypad.
- 4. Suggestion: Program the gate phone number of 772-999-6854 into your contact list on your phone.


